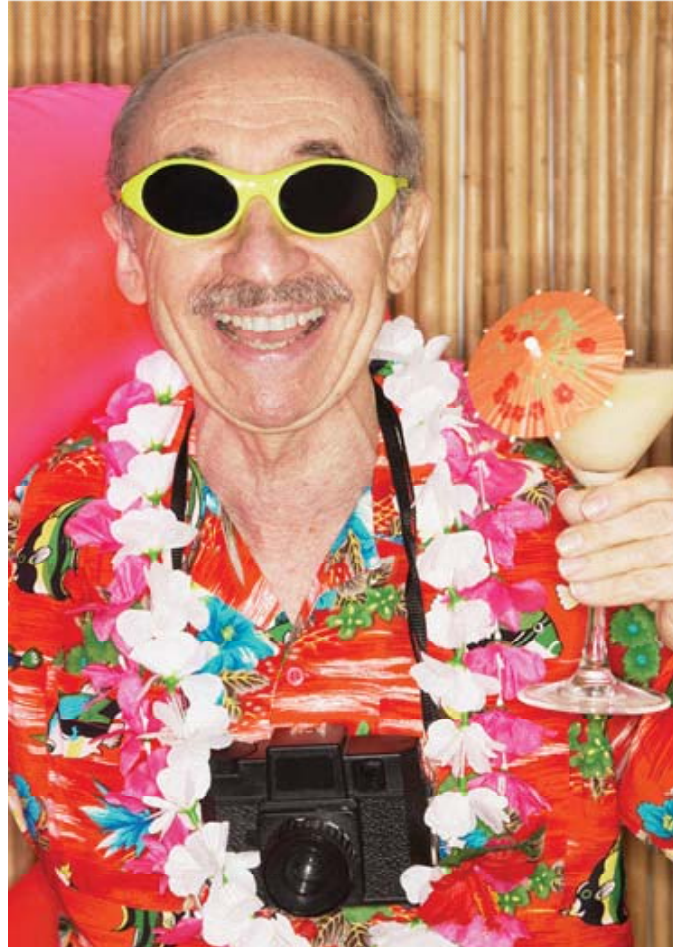


Cultural Studies

Instructional topics include: how language and social customs form a cultural identity; the role of history and geography on the formation of a culture; understanding the culture through language (English) acquisition and conversation; understanding the culture of the United States through its literature, visual and performing arts; understanding the culture through its cuisine, sports, leisure and recreation; and the importance of community and intergenerational cultural experiences.
